

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

Student and Faculty Survey Update

THANK YOU to ALL who completed your 2007 surveys. We appreciate you taking your time to provide this important information.

We only have a few institutions who have not started or completed their student and faculty surveys. To check the status of FAEIS surveys at your institution, please see the FAEIS 2007 Survey Status Report.

And don't forget, in addition to the traditional FAEIS surveys, the <u>International Programs</u> <u>Database</u> that began January 2008 is also open for your data input.

Annual FAEIS User Survey Results

Here are a few results from the 2008 FAEIS User Survey. There were 285 respondents to the survey. To see the <u>full set of survey results, click here</u>.

<u>Question 6</u>. Rate the usefulness of the data resources in FAEIS (for student enrollment, degrees awarded and placement, disciplines, gender, ethnicity, faculty salaries, etc.). 1=not useful; 5=very useful

1 (not useful) - 4.3% 2 - 8.2% 3 - 17.6% 4 - 19.4% 5 - (very useful) - 13.6% No answer - 2.9% Not used - 34.1%

When "No answer" and "Not Used" were eliminated from analysis, the Mean Score = 3.47. (N = 176)

<u>Question 7</u>. Please rate the usefulness of FAEIS at your institution for internal applications (institutional benchmarking, student and faculty recruitment, faculty hiring and fundraising). 1=not useful; 5=very useful

1 (not useful) - 4.7% 2 - 11.5% 3 - 19.4% 4 - 14.4% 5 - (very useful) - 6.8% No answer - 7.2% Not used - 36%

When "No answer" and "Not Used" were eliminated from analysis, the Mean Score = 3.13. (N = 158)

<u>Question 8</u>. Describe your level of satisfaction with FAEIS components. (i.e., newsletter help desk, data entry, report builder, instructions) 1=not satisfied; 5=very satisfied

1 (not satisfied) - 3.6%

2 - 5%

3 - 25.1%

4 - 27.6%

5 - (very satisfied) - 13.3% No answer or unknown - 1.8%

Not used - 23.7%

When "No answer," "unknown," and "Not Used" were eliminated from analysis, the Mean Score = 3.56. (N = 208)
