

### Citizenship of Agriculture Faculty and PhD Graduates


The percentage of Agriculture faculty who are non-U.S. citizens has increased by over 50% between 2003 and 2007. Also, non-U.S. citizens account for 25% of new faculty hires in Agriculture at the Assistant Professor rank, an increase of 40% since 2003. This is due in no small part to the high percentage (33-42%) of non-U.S. citizens receiving PhDs in Agriculture, Agriculture Operations, and Related Sciences. The charts below are derived from all the institutions reporting student and faculty surveys in FAEIS.

## Non-U.S. Citizen Component of Agriculture Faculty




**Look at the Number of Faculty by Citizenship Status**
