

Average Salaries of Adminstrative Faculty



The last set of two pie charts show percentage and numbers of faculty by program area and by academic rank.

2007 Average Salary by Administrative Position and Program Area for 1862 Land-Grant Institutions




Institutions Participating in Administrative Faculty Salary Surveys

2007 Average Salary by Administrative Position and Program Area for 1890 Land-Grant Institutions





2007 Average Salary by Administrative Position and Program Area for Non-Land-Grant Institutions




