Triennial FAEIS Evaluation

This month we will launch our Triennial Evaluation of the Food and Agricultural Education Information System (FAEIS). Every three years the FAEIS office conducts a comprehensive review of the system in order to remain relevant to your needs. All FAEIS users, including those who complete data entry, faculty, and administrators should have received an email message with a web-link to the evaluation tool. 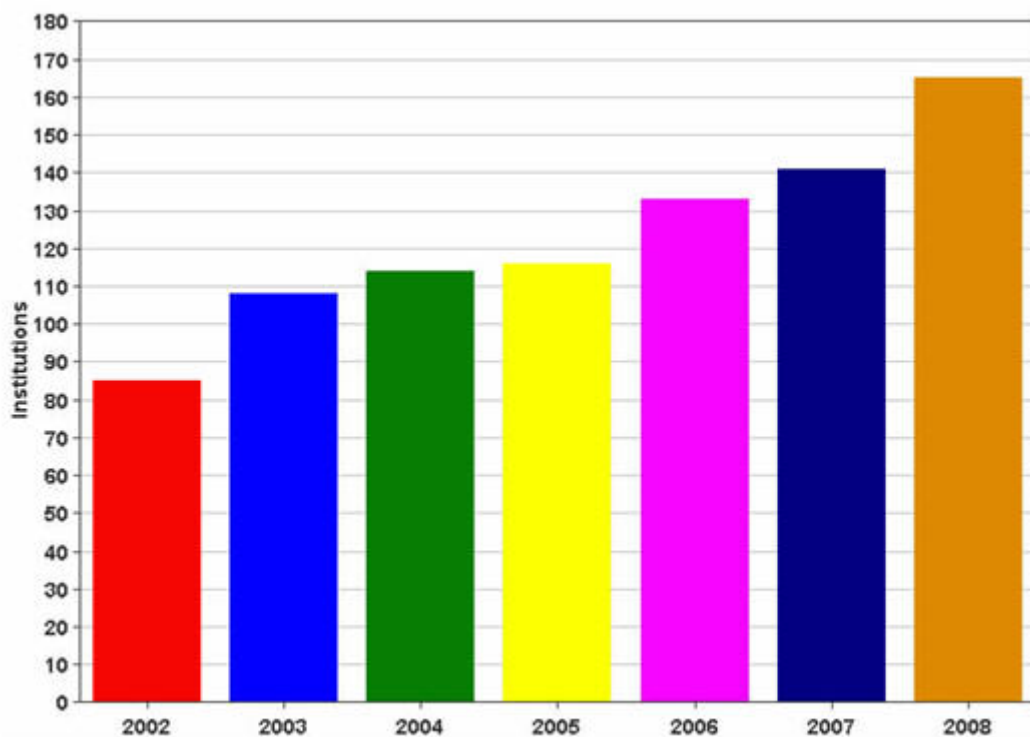
