

FAEIS Placement by Occupational Group Data File

Required Variables

Survey Year	The survey year for which you are submitting the data file.
Academic Unit	Academic unit (college and/or department name) where the academic program is located.
CIP Code	The six-digit classification code that best describes the program.
Program Name	Either the program name as it exists at your institution or the CIP name.
Degree Level	The degree the student attained at your institution.
Occupational Group	The occupational group the student went into within six months of graduation.
Placement Area	The students placement area.
Occupational Count	The total number of students from the specified program with the specified characteristics who went into that occupational group. Please only consider paid employment. Do not count internships or volunteer positions.
